SCE Officer Spotlights

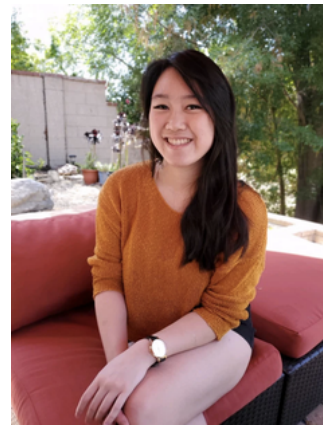
Megan Mannion – Mentorship Chair
