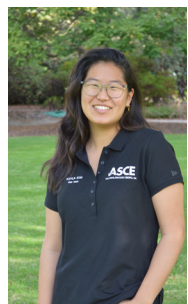

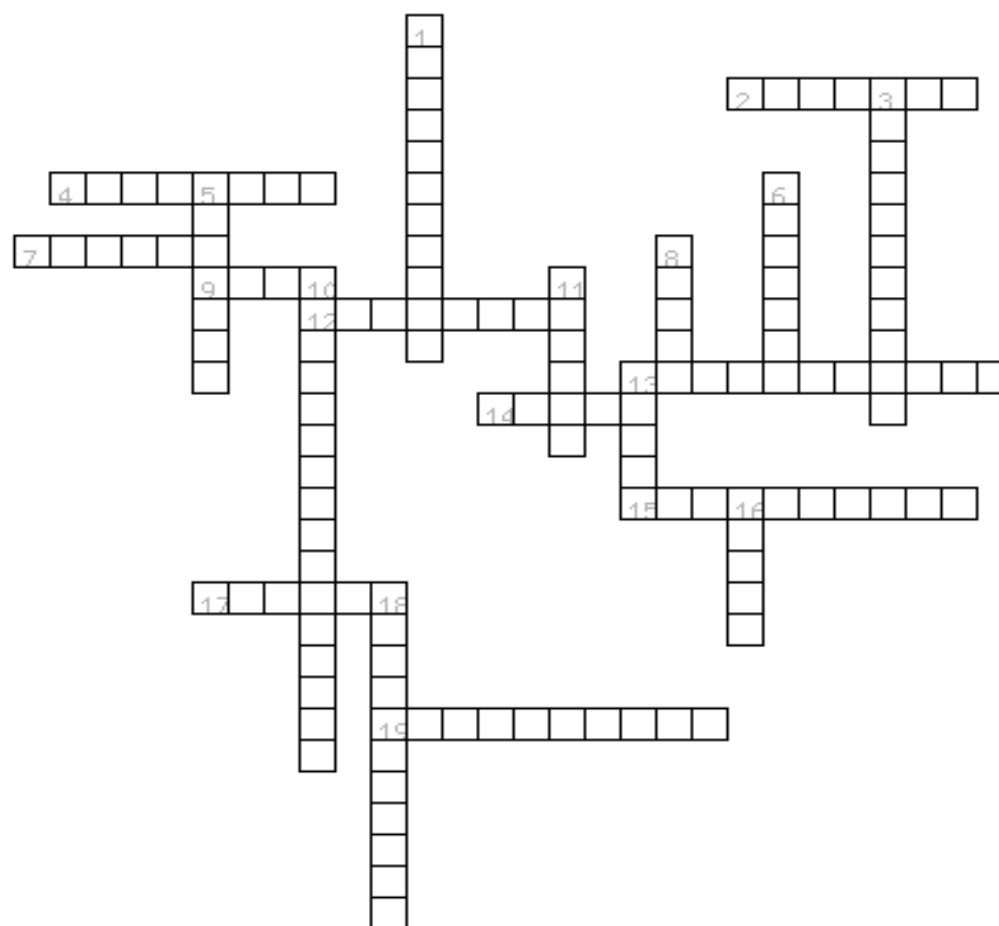
Tonight's Speaker
