**Favorite Hobby?** Running, biking, hiking or surfing

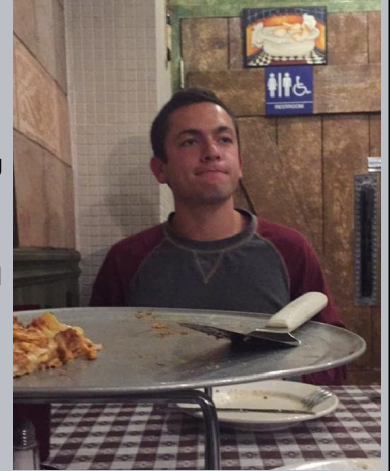
**Favorite Cartoon?** Fairly Oddparents
